## ESSAY REQUIREMENTS

In memory of Coach Charlie Story a beloved basketball coach, mentor, confidant, and role model, all senior student athletes attending Faith Christian Academy have the opportunity to earn a \$500.00 scholarship to help them achieve their continued educational goals. Coach Story was a stickler for details, hard work and dedication to your task.

In his memory, a scholarship committee has been formed and will be accepting essays to determine which senior student athlete will be awarded the inaugural scholarship. Listed below are questions that should be answered in your essay. Your essay should have a minimum of 500 words, typed, double spaced and presented in a professional manner with a title page that includes the authors (your) name.

Questions that should be answered in your essay are:

1. What impact has sports had on your life and how will you use what you have learned in the future?
2. What are your academic / career goals?
3. Give an example of a time that you had a belief or idea challenged with your perceived outcome of the situation.
4. Tell the committee about yourself.
5. Give an example of a time that you failed and what you learned from it.
6. Discuss your background, identity, and your interest.
7. What do you want to study and why?
8. Why do you deserve this scholarship and how will it help you?

Your class will be one of the last group of seniors that Coach Story was able to spend time with, teach and mentor, Please include in your essay any lesson you learned from Coach Story that has helped you on or off the court and explain the lesson and how it helped you.

And finally, all essays must be submitted by April 22, 2022. Whomever is chosen by the committee will be announced at Graduation or as allowed by FCA. We look forward to reading your essays.
